ARMENIANS ARE MASSACRED BY THE WHOLESALE

(Scripps News Association.)

BERLIN, July 25.—The Frankfurter Zeitung reports Armenian massacres are in full swing again. The villages of Gomer, Blel, Gnarker, Kzilaghodi, Karoudi and Terquevank, near Lake Van, have been plundered and all males massacred. Women and children were tortured and outraged.

Similar slaughter has been reported in the neighborhood of Mush, where from 60 to 80 Armenians have been killed every night. The Turks killed almost the entire population of Oregounk.
